Accuracy: Jurij Vega. In the Prologue to his Logarithmic tables he promised to pay a ducat for every mistake.

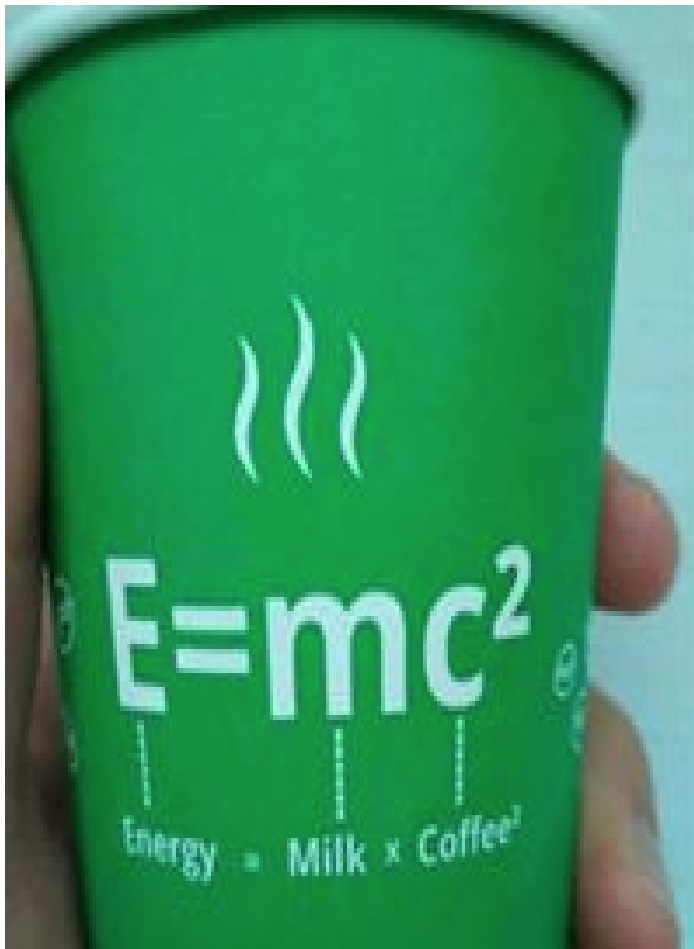

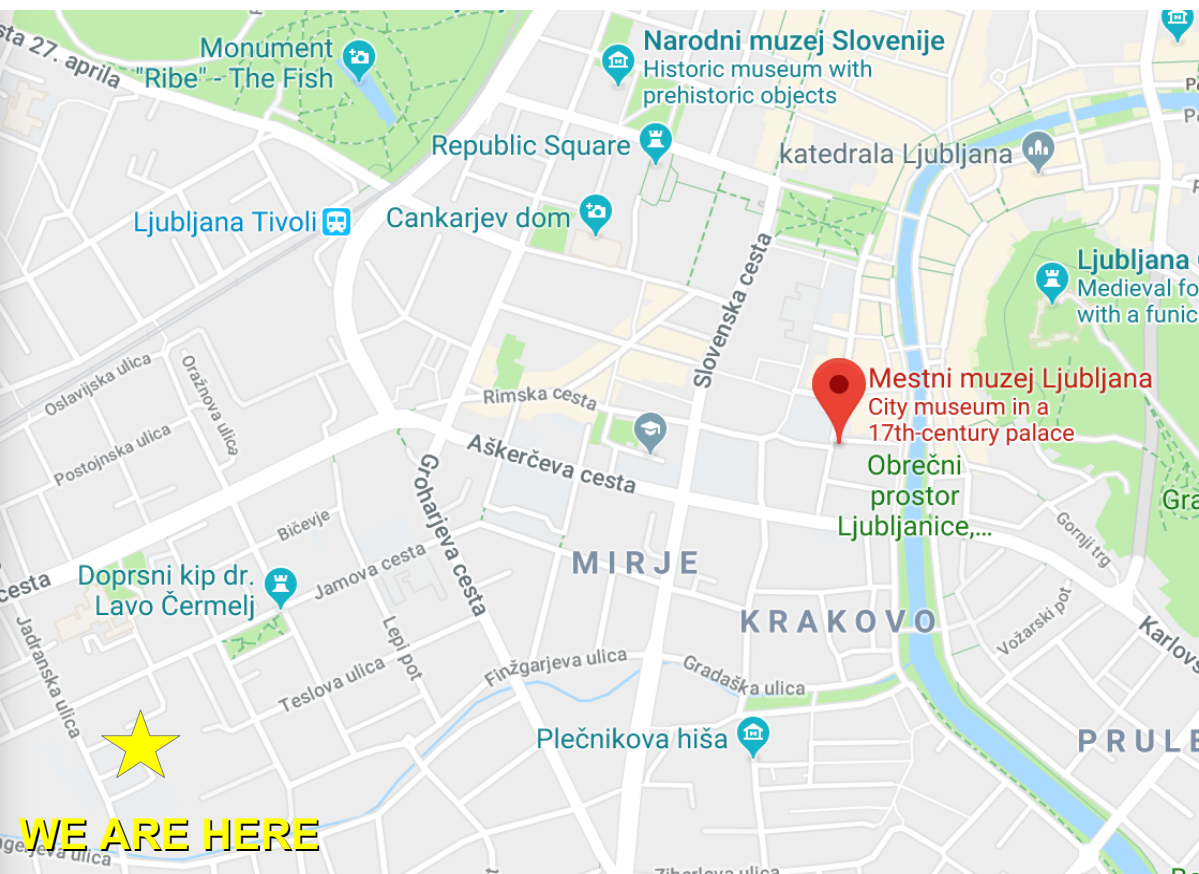
